

Uniform Policy 2018-2019

The identity of St. Joan of Arc children as students in a Catholic school is evident in the uniform. Although outward appearances are not a judge of character, taking care to groom and dress appropriately projects a sense of discipline, unity, pride and respect. Thank you for your support and assistance with the uniform policy.

Jumpers Grades K-3 ONLY

Skirts Grades 4-8 ONLY

Uniform plaid only; no navy (sold at Reisse Brothers).

No shorter than 3 inches above kneecap, front and back.

Navy, white or red tights/leggings may be worn under jumpers or skirts only (not as pants).

Shirts

White, red or light blue. (4-8 may also wear navy).

Short or long sleeved, collared golf/polo.

No logo (except SJOA).

Must be tucked in at all times.

Pants/Shorts

Navy blue (4-8 may also wear khaki).

Shorts allowed in August, September, April, May and June.

Shorts must be no shorter than 3 inches above kneecap.

Tailored uniform; cotton or synthetic blends (no baggy, cargo or athletic shorts).

Belts required (except in Kindergarten).

Sweaters/Sweatshirts

Navy, red or white only.

No logos (except SJOA).

SJOA spirit wear sweatshirt is permitted.

Socks: Worn at all times; black or white crew/ankle cut.

Shoes: tennis shoes/sneakers or brown/black dress shoes ONLY. No light up shoes.

Tennis shoes must be worn on P.E. days.

Boots worn for weather must be changed upon arrival.

Hair, Skin, Makeup

Hair must be neat, clean and groomed. Not hanging in face.

Hair coloring is not permitted.

Tattoos (real or fake) are not permitted.

Noiseless watches may be worn.

No hats worn inside.

Makeup and fake nails are not permitted.

Spirit Wear Days

First Friday of each month.

SJOA spirit wear or SJOA CYO athletic shirt with jeans, SJOA athletic shorts/sweatpants or uniform shorts/pants.

During 4th quarter, 8th grade may wear high school spirit apparel.
